H.M. Customs Bermuda Case Study

Scanning customs forms makes travelling to Bermuda smooth sailing.

H.M. Customs Bermuda is responsible for the collection and protection of approx. one-third of the Bermuda Government revenue. All visitors and residents arriving by air or cruise ship are required to complete Customs Declaration forms before they clear Immigration. Completed forms were collected and stored in a satellite office. If additional follow up was needed, H.M. Customs Bermuda had to manually retrieve the forms. This caused the process to be extremely slow, and the associated costs of having to locate, retrieve and deliver the declaration forms were high. They realised this was a problem, and tendered a bid from A.F. Smith to provide a solution.

H.M. Customs Bermuda had very specific needs. They wanted to capture the front and back of all declaration forms, over 80 per arriving flight, and create a single PDF file out of them. However, because there is important information on both sides of the document, they wanted the front and back to appear on one page, side-by-side. Price was also a factor, so purchasing a scanner with a 100+ page automatic document feeder (ADF) was not possible.

A custom solution was built using a Xerox DocuMate 3640 scanner bundled with Kofax VRS Professional software. A departmental duplex flatbed scanner that scans up to 80 ipm in duplex mode, the DocuMate 3640 also has Ultrasonic Double Feed Detection to ensure that no pages are skipped. Although their budget limited them from purchasing a high-capacity ADF scanner, the Xerox DocuMate 3640's OneTouch Driver includes a continuous scan feature, so paper can be added to the current scan job and allows files to be created with a number of pages greater than its 80 page ADF

capacity. The OneTouch driver was also customised to scan to a network folder where multiple users would have access. Kofax VRS Professional software was used to achieve optimal image quality at the point of capture. This was critical to the document capture process because image quality significantly impacts the success of data extraction, recognition, and retrieval. Kofax VRS was used to produce clean, crisp scans, and minimised the amount of document preparation required.

Now, when a flight arrives, all customs declaration forms are collected and scanned into a multipage PDF file. The file is named according to the flight number and arrival date. When a form needs to be retrieved, an administrator simply searches by flight and date and locates the file.

H.M. Customs Bermuda no longer has to retrieve hard copies of these forms to examine them and therefore eliminated all transportation, storage and labour costs associated with retrieving them from storage. The scanning solution is now completely electronic and forms are instantly accessible by Customs officials via the internal network when needed.



Introducing the Xerox DocuMate 4760

The Xerox DocuMate 4760 is a high quality production sheetfed scanner that scans documents at 60 ppm (simplex) and 120 ipm (duplex), and includes a 150-page capacity Automatic Document Feeder (ADF). The new affordable scanner has the ability to scan a wide range of mixed document sizes (up to A3) and supports long document scanning up to 965 mm.

The DocuMate 4760 is an ideal back office production scanner in a paper intensive environment, especially one where document sizes may regularly exceed A4 and vary to the other extreme of business cards or plastic ID cards. Ultrasonic Double Feed Detection is built in so a page will never be skipped due to a misfeed or a stapled document going through the scanner. The DocuMate 4760 offers a professional software package, together with advanced TWAIN and ISIS drivers, to enable communication with advanced electronic content management (ECM) software applications such as Xerox DocuShare and Microsoft SharePoint.

Keep on Trucking... A Visioneer Case Study

L&L Transportation needed to find a cost-effective solution to capture and send freight documents, eliminate postage costs and speed up the billing cycle from time of delivery.

L&L Transportation provides transportation services for propane, anhydrous ammonia and natural gas liquids across the Eastern half of the United States. It maintains a fleet of trucks and trailers, as well as offering maintenance and repair services.

L&L drivers are on the road 90% of their work day and after each delivery is made, their signed delivery receipts need to get back to the corporate office as soon as possible to begin the client billing. Documents were previously mailed via the US post office, but this method was expensive, slow and required additional processing personnel. L&L needed to find a solution that would reduce costs and time.



L&L really wanted to find a solution that could create digital images and send them via email to the dispatch department. They first chose to utilize Samsung Galaxy tablets tied to the Verizon Wireless network to handle the digital communication between their dispatch department and their drivers. Next, they looked for a way to have their drivers capture images of the freight documents. They researched small affordable scanners that could send images to their tablets.

The Visioneer Mobility Air was the only scanner that they could find that was affordable for mass distribution and was compatible with the Android Tablet. Visioneer Mobility Air is a small colour scanner powered by a rechargeable battery, takes only 10 seconds to scan a page and then immediately transfers the files to the Android tablet via Wi-Fi, and they are ready to be emailed to dispatch. Richard Widdicombe, from L&L says 'We chose this configuration due to cost and ease-of-use. We could have chosen a packaged GPS tracking and communication system already available for fleets but the equipment and monthly maintenance fees are expensive. Our tablet and scanner hardware cost was roughly 10% of the expense of an alternative packaged system.

The entire fleet is now using the tablet/scanner combination and L&L's cash flow and receivables have greatly improved because billing cycles are much faster with shipments, invoices and payments cycling through the corporate office in just 3 or 4 days instead of weeks. The corporate office has also reduced their paper and copy machine usage and they are projecting a saving of \$25,000 annually in postage costs.
